This document is a User Guide for the Energy Support Program (ESP) designed for New & Existing manufacturing entities in the Emirates of Abu Dhabi and includes an overview description of the ESP, the auditing process, the criteria and all necessary information needed to fulfil the program requirements, including the process to be followed by the manufacturing entities for enrolling in the program.

The program consists of three main criteria that manufacturing entities will be audited against, that will determine the score based on which support will be provided.

The Industrial Development Bureau will provide guidance and support to applicants throughout the auditing process journey of the program.

Terms and Glossary

- Eligibility Criteria A set of criteria which if achieved enables the industrial project to become eligible to qualify for energy support program.
- Existing Companies Manufacturing Entities which are in operation/production for more than 6 months from date of issue of the production/operational license from ADDED
- New Companies a. Manufacturing Entities which have "under construction" license issued by ADDED
 - b. Manufacturing Entities having a "Production License" that are less than 6 months old from the date of the ESP application.
- Balanced Score Card A performance metric used to measure and provide feedback on manufacturing entities performance in order to acquire the needed points to be eligible for the specified categories in the ESP.
- Governance The way in which a manufacturing entity controls responsibility and decision making to ensure accountability and actions are suitably managed.
- Standard Tariff The existing Abu Dhabi Energy tariffs for industrial projects.
- Gas Natural gas supplied to industrial consumers through gas pipeline network by the developer.
- Calculation Reference All numbers referenced in the application are the year of the application itself. Manufacturer could not apply utilizing older information.
- Application Validity ESP Application validity is only for 3 months by which time the entire audit and certification process is required to be completed. The Industrial Development Bureau reserves the right to reject/re-initiate the application.

Introduction

The Energy Support Program (ESP) is intended to support manufacturing entities and industrial investors in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi through providing preferential electricity and gas tariffs based on a set eligibility criteria.

Eligibility criteria includes the manufacturing entity's economic impact (including investments in Abu Dhabi, spending on logistics etc.), productivity (including value added per employee), Natural Gas(for industries using natural gas) demand management and energy management efficiency.

The program aims to support the private industrial sector by enhancing their economic impact and thrust their productivity by offering preferential Gas and Electrical rates to promote competitiveness in the industrial sector in Abu Dhabi Emirate.

Objectives of the program

- 1. Improve the efficiency of the energy usage & optimize the natural gas usage in the industrial sector of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi and contribute towards the UAE's net zero goal
- 2. Enhancing the economic impact of the industrial sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi
- 3. Boost productivity in the Industrial Sector by encouraging through technology transformation
- 4. Reduce operational expenses

Overall Description of Energy Support Program


The program was established to promote the competitiveness of Abu Dhabi as a manufacturing hub.

Entities can opt for obtaining certificate for the Energy Support Program pertaining to:

- 1. Electricity only
- 2. Gas only
- 3. Both Electricity and Gas.

The criteria for evaluating economic impact & productivity are the same for the three options mentioned above. Additionally, the criteria for electricity scoring is based on the connected load and availability of the entity's Energy Management System, while for the gas scoring, the criteria is based on the natural gas demand management.

Figure 1: ESP scoring criteria for New & Existing Companies – Electricity & Gas



*Prices are subject to change.

Manufacturing entities can select their respective option and obtain separate certificates for Electricity and Gas.

For Electricity:

- Preferential Rates covers the consumption amount benefitted directly towards the manufacturing entity's electricity bill.
- Preferential tariff is valid for one year and factories should apply for the next year to ensure that the criteria is met year-on-year that is reflected in the manufacturing entity's economic performance, productivity improvements and energy efficiency. Entities should apply well within the expiry of the current certificate to ensure continuity.



If the manufacturing entity scores less than 50 points, the currently prevailing standard tariff will be charged accordingly.

For Gas:

- covers the consumption amount which will be obtained through rebate mechanism paid directly to the beneficiary upon completion of each quarter.
- Discount valid for one year and manufacturing entities should apply for the next to ensure that the criteria is met year-on-year that is reflected in the manufacturing entity's economic performance, productivity improvements and the natural gas demand management. Entities should apply well within the expiry of the current certificate to ensure continuity.

If the manufacturing entity scored less than 50 points, the prevailing standard tariff will be charged accordingly.

The Evaluation Criteria

1. Economic Impact

Economic Impact – aims to build a robust value chain in the industrial sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi by creating employment opportunities for UAE nationals and increase the skilled resources in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

For Economic impact for New Companies, the following attributes are considered for assessment:

(i) Investment in Abu Dhabi;

(ii) Investment Top Up Score.

2. Abu Dhabi (AD) Logistics

AD Logistics – aims to build a robust value chain across the logistics sector and its contribution to the industrial sector in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

For AD Logistics for New Companies, the following attributes are considered:

- (i) Abu Dhabi Logistics Charges;
- (ii) UAE logistics charges.

Figure 4: AD Logistics Criteria – New Companies



The weight of supply chain criteria with relation to the total score is 30%. For Existing Companies, the AD Logistics Criteria is part of the Economic Impact evaluation.

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3. Productivity Criteria

Productivity refers to how well an organization converts input (such as labor, materials, machines and capital) into outputs. The productivity is important as it drives the economy towards growth and attracts more investments due to the increase in profit when productivity increases. Assessing productivity can help the manufacturing entities to reduce the risk of costly errors and improve the ways to do business.

The productivity will be based on the value addition done by the manufacturing entity based on the total number of employees. Productivity output is capped at 1 (i.e., does not exceed 100% of the score).

The Productivity Criteria is only applicable to Existing Companies.

The number of workers considered will be the number of workers paid under WPS of the entity as well as any outsourced workforce contributing to the entity's productivity.

Productivity score will be based on comparing the incremental improvement in the productivity ratio when taken in comparison to the previous year's actual productivity. The "Base Year Productivity" for those companies who will join for the first time will receive the full score as this will be their baseline.

Thus, previous year actual productivity will be used for evaluation of productivity score of each year for all the applicants after Base Year with degree of improvement over previous year productivity capped at 10%. A 10% improvement is progressive; thus a 10% improvement will correspond to a 100% productivity improvement score.



For the selection of industrial sector for any supplier, the major revenue stream from commercial activity will be considered, if a company has more than once revenue stream or production lines.

* Financial Income is excluded from the Revenue.

* Production cost is the cost incurred for the respective entity during the specified year of produced product.

4. Connection load and Energy Management System (Electricity):

The manufacturing entity will submit its site power connection details and Single Line Diagram for assessing the connectivity load. If the site is distribution connected for power, the connected load can be greater than, equal to or less than 5MW as stated in ADDC/AADC Site.

Both New & Existing Manufacturing entities, irrespective of their connection load, can be considered in the ESP. For entities having more than 5MW, 10% will be considered while the other 10% will be reviewed against Energy Management System checklist. For Manufacturing entities having less that 5MW, the full 20% will be reviewed against the Energy Management System checklist.

The total score of the connection load / EMS has a total weightage of 20%.

The Energy Management parameters, as approved by ADDC/AADC will also be submitted for evaluating the company for energy efficiency parameter.

5. Demand Management System (Gas):

The manufacturing entity will scan and submit the respective gas demand data pertaining to their requested consumption and actual consumption in the preceding year. AD Ports being the Gas provider in the industrial zones, will provide the given percentages of consumption towards the initial requested demand. As per the agreement with AD Ports the applicable tariff

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for Gas will remain at 95% of the requested demand irrespective if the actual consumption is far less.

Considering this aspect of Demand management, the ESP considers the accuracy and appropriate planning of the natural gas demand and therefore will categorize scoring in this section as per the figure 4 below. For entities that are in the first year of contract with AD Ports, full score will be given under the Demand Management Side criteria.

Energy Support Program (ESP)

The program aims to support private manufacturing entities by enhancing their economic impact and improve their productivity by offering preferential Gas and Electrical rates to promote competitiveness and sustainability in the Emirates of Abu Dhabi.

Eligibility for the preferential tariffs is based on a criteria that includes economic impact, spending on logistics in Abu Dhabi, electric efficiency and/ or gas demand management efficiency.

Below are some important highlights of the terms and conditions of the support program:

- 1. Entities can opt for Electricity, Gas or Electricity and Gas both depending on their interest and requirements.
- 2. Any entities joining the program for the first time will their current year productivity as a base and be eligible for a full productivity score. The current productivity will be used for assessing incremental improvement in subsequent years.
- 3. Entities with a valid ESP certificate opting for the preferential gas tariff can utilize the same data already used for the ESP for economic & productivity impacts.

The only variable is the DMS score which needs to be ascertained to obtain a valid score for Gas. This can be applied through "Addition of Benefit" option. The validity of the certificate will remain the same as the existing ESP certificate, where the entity will then renew under the ESP for both Electricity and Gas.

4. All entities having existing ESP certificates are required to complete the full validity period and re-apply for ESP certificate renewal to ensure continuity of benefit.

Entities with existing score and validity will not be able to re-apply with the same financial statements to obtain a higher score. Also, no same financial statements can be used to apply for multiple ESP certificates.

- 5. Entities whose ESP certificates have lapsed and wish to rejoin the program will still undergo the evaluation process under the established criteria. Productivity and all related elements will still apply to the applicant and the certificate validity will be from the date when it is approved, and not retroactively, from the date of previous expiry
- 6. IDB reserves the right to evaluate each application independently and case to case approval of technical clarifications pertaining to the application and transition can be forwarded to IDB through the concerned Certifying Body for approval prior to engagement.



7. Preferential gas tariff will not apply directly towards the billing, rather will be settled every quarter. This will require submission of consumption bills and proof of payment, along with bank account confirmation letter.



Procedures

- 1. A list of the required documents and forms can be accessed from https://idb.added.gov.ae/Programs/ESP
- 2. Log in to the E- services using the existing portal username and password. <u>https://www.adbc.gov.ae/CitizenAccess/Welcome.aspx</u> alternatively use TAMM system.
- 3. On the main dashboard menu select "Energy Support Request".
- 4. Select the industrial license number you want to obtain for the benefits.
- 5. Insert the contact details (name, email and phone number)
- 6. You will be directed to an upload screen to upload all the required documents as specified on the website.
- 7. Once all the required documents have been uploaded, you will be directed to the review page and CB's selection.
- 8. Click on submit application (RFQ) and select 3 or more certifying bodies for a quote.
- 9. The short-listed certifying bodies will receive an intimation to quote, will review the documents and prepare the quotation. Any additional requirements will be specifically requested by the CB's if needed.
- 10. You will receive notifications when either the additional requirements or the quotations are submitted to which the entity is required to respond appropriately.
- 11. Log in to your account and review the received quotations from the certifying bodies to award to one of them.
- 12. The certifying body will commence auditing the application based on the identified criteria. You can be contacted by certifying body for further clarification.
- 13. Based on your choice, Distribution companies or AD ports will provide an input into the application (e.g., connection load or Demand Side Management or both) for approval or otherwise.
- 14. The certifying body will issue a balance score card specifying the achieved score in addition to a report summarizing your scores.
- 15. You need to sign the balance score card.
- 16. If the manufacturing entity fulfills all requirements and achieves a score of 50 points and above, IDB will issue an enrollment certificate to the program specifying the final score and the awarded category. Kindly note that the validity of the enrollment certificate is (1) one year from date of issue.
- 17. For Electricity, the distribution companies (ADDC or AADC, depending on the location of the entity) will be approached with the enrolment certificate to obtain the preferential tariff for your industrial entity.
- 18. For Gas tariff, the following will be submitted to IDB on quarterly basis as evidence:



- a. Gas Consumption data for the completed quarter in the form of invoices and respective billing
- b. Proof of payment supporting made in full toward the gas bills
- c. Bank account confirmation certificate from the bank addressed to IDB (once annually)

Accordingly, this information to be submitted to IDB to apply for reimbursement of the tariff difference, which will be paid direct to the beneficiaries account.

- 19. If the manufacturing entity score is below 50 points a regret letter will be issued from IDB, and you will be charged with the Standard Industrial Tariff. However, you are still eligible to reapply should any of the criteria be met at a later stage.
- 20. For any renewal applications, certificate validity will start from the date of previous certificate expiry valid for one year as per the new score. Time frame for renewal application will be **<u>90 days</u>** prior to expiry date to obtain renewal terms of one year from expiry date. Any application renewed before this will result in certificate issue date on actual approval date of the renewal.

2- Who is eligible to apply for Energy Support Program (ESP) program and does the Program cover other consumers than industrial?	All the industrial facilities in Abu Dhabi holding valid industrial license issued by the IDB are eligible to apply for the program. The Program was established by the Industrial Development Bureau to cover all Industrial sectors in Abu Dhabi except Free Zone Entities.
3- What type of industrial activities are included?	All industrial activities approved within the emirates of Abu Dhabi are applicable for the program.

The certification dates will be unified towards the existing certificate so that when reapplying, the entity can apply for both Electricity and Gas together under the Energy Support Program.
8- Who will have access to my documents since they are highly confidential?	All documents will be managed confidentially by the designated teams.
9- What are the benefits from the Program?	Manufacturing Entities could potentially qualify for special tariffs based on a set of criteria reflecting their economic value and their cost-to-serve.
10-Can Applicants with no existing factory in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi apply for the program?	The program is designed only for manufacturing entities in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.
11-How Can I apply for this Program?	You can apply online by visiting <u>https://idb.added.gov.ae/Programs/ESP/how-to-</u> apply_and following the instructions.
12-Can I hire my own Auditor for the ESP program?	The ESP certification is done by independent third parties knowns as Certifying Bodies that are selected and empaneled under the program by ADDED.
13-What is the evaluation process for my ESP application for New Companies?	 Following criteria will be used to evaluate the new manufacturing entities in order to qualify for the ESP program under various categories: Economic Impact Abu Dhabi Logistics Connectivity Load

As part of the Energy Support Program - ESP, ADDED has empaneled the Certifying Bodies to evaluate and verify all ESP applications under the Program (<u>A</u> <u>list of certifying bodies is provided in the User</u> <u>Guideline for ESP and also posted on the website</u> <u>https://idb.added.gov.ae/Programs/ESP/cbs</u> .

1- Audited Financial Report

All applicants are required to provide the financial statements available for the last available financial year, such that the audited statements are not older than 18 months from the date the application reaches IDB for final review. For companies exceeding 6 months in operation and do not have audited financial statements, the management accounts for a period no less than 6 months can be used for ESP calculations.

In case the supplier prepares consolidated financials for a group of companies and has more than one factory operating under the entity, then the supplier needs to submit the **<u>audited financials</u>** of each factory which should reconcile with consolidated financials. The audited financial statements must be IFRS compliant.

In case Supplier has consolidated or combined financials and it is not a group of companies having separate factories operating under the entity, however, operates with separate licenses under the same entity (such as branch license, commercial license, free zone licenses in other Emirates etc.) approval from IDB to be obtained prior to proceeding with ESP application. This is for consideration from IDB if the consolidated financials can be considered, if separate audited standalone financials are required or whether Management Accounts breakup certified by the supplier can be accepted and the level of sampling that is required. The approval and requirements are at sole discretion of Industrial Development Bureau.

Companies are not eligible to apply for the ESP using the same audited financial statements 2 years in a row despite the period being less than 18 months.

2- General Questionnaire

All applicants are required to fill in the questionnaire based on the reported financial year. The details provided in the questionnaire will not be considered for economic impact calculation or auditing.

3- Investment

A. Assets Description

Fixed Assets **owned** by the Manufacturing Entity as per the Audited Financial Statement along with the location (i.e., Inside Abu Dhabi or Outside Abu Dhabi).

Fixed Assets will include the following categories:

- (i) Property, Plant and Equipment (including any ERP costs)
- (ii) For IT companies, software development costs will also be included
- (iii) Capital Work in progress
- (iv) Investment Property

Energy Support Program

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All other intangibles must be excluded from investments

The investments outside the Emirate of Abu Dhabi should also be reflected appropriately in the manufacturing entities submission template.

In case the manufacturing entities has revalued their property, plant and equipment, the value of the property, plant and equipment shall be reduced by the extent of the balance in the revaluation reserve at the balance sheet date.

B. Gross Book Value

For all the assets listed, the manufacturing entities shall provide the Gross Book Value as per the Audited Financial Statements.

C. Location

Manufacturing entities shall select one of the locations from value list – "Inside Abu Dhabi" or "Outside Abu Dhabi"

D. Investment Calculation:

The investment is calculated as under:

Gross Value of Assets in Abu Dhabi / Gross book Value of Total Assets




Figure 2: Process flow diagram
